Some of the topics covered include:

- Be able to identify the elements of an effective poster.
- Apply design principles and work with templates.
- View and analyze real-world poster examples.
- Receive tips for presenting with confidence
- Exchange constructive poster feedback in a positive environment

The workshop will conclude with peer-to-peer open sharing time, where participants are welcome to give or receive feedback while sharing posters. There will also be ample time to ask questions and receive feedback on your poster if you wish.
